Gerlinde Kaltenbrunner

on Thursday, February 1st at 7pm at WeXelerate, Praterstrasse 1, Space 14/15, 1020 Vienna.

Gerlinde Kaltenbrunner has climbed all fourteen main peaks in the eight thousand series. By reaching the summit of K2 (8,611m), the second highest peak in the world, she has become the first woman to scale all 8,000m peaks without the use of bottled oxygen. She is one of only two women who have climbed all 8,000m peaks. Gerlinde Kaltenbrunner will speak about her life and the parallels to leadership and is looking forward to answering your questions. Please note that the presentation will be held in German.

There is no entry fee for this event. There will be the opportunity to support Nepali aid, a non-profit organization which builds schools, health posts and orphanages. Gerlinde has been supporting this organization for many years. Please note that space is limited.
