A member of the Notre Dame faculty since 1980, Prof. Schmuhl has served since 1997 as director of the University's John W. Gallivan Program in Journalism, Ethics & Democracy. His teaching and research focus on American political life, journalism and contemporary affairs. Prof. Schmuhl is the author or editor of nine books, including "Demanding Democracy" (1994), "Statecraft and Stagecraft: American Political Life in the Age of Personality" (1990 and 1992), and "Wounded Titans: American Presidents and the Perils of Power" (1996). His edited volume, "The Responsibilities of Journalism," has been published in four foreign editions and translations since appearing in 1984.

Prof. Schmuhl's academic articles and reviews have been published in such journals as Critical Studies in Mass Communication, The Review of Politics, Style, National Forum, and Journalism Quarterly. He also has worked extensively in journalism, writing features, columns and reviews for dozens of newspapers and magazines, including The Washington Post, USA Today, Sports Illustrated, Editor and Publisher, The Chicago Tribune, The Philadelphia Inquirer and The Boston Globe.

Prof. Schmuhl received his bachelor's degree from Notre Dame in 1970 and his master's and doctoral degrees in English and American studies from Indiana University in 1978.
