Dr. Dietrich Liko has studied Physics and Computer Science at the Technical University of Vienna. He performed his PhD thesis as Austrian delegate at CERN, the European research centre in Geneva. There, he was dealing with the lifetime measurement of Hadrons. After his thesis he joined the CERN staff team and continued his research in the ATLAS experiment to justify the existence of the Higgs Boson.

Based on the CERN results the Swedish Nobel Prize Committee awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics 2013 jointly to François Englert and Peter W. Higgs "for the theoretical discovery of a mechanism that contributes to our understanding of the origin of mass of subatomic particles" – commonly known as “Higgs Boson”.

Today Dr. Liko is heading the Physics Computing Department of the Institute of High Energy Physics of the Austria Academy of Sciences.
